General Information

Swimming skills: You don't need to be a super swimmer, but you will need to display a comfortable ability in the water.

Fitness: Prior to starting your scuba course, you will be required to complete a medical history form. If the medical history form of the student indicates any condition contrary to participation in scuba diving activities, the student will be required to secure a medical approval by a licensed medical practitioner.

How long will it take? With our 'Comfort Through Repetition' teaching philosophy, you will develop real world diving skills, this allows you to progress at a pace that is comfortable for you. Typically the course runs over one evening and two weekends.

What do you need to bring? To learn to dive, all you need is a swimsuit, towel, snorkelling gear and a sense of adventure! All scuba equipment is loaned to you as part of your course cost.

Equipment requirements: Diving requires the use of a face mask, snorkel, fins and dive boots, Workplace Health and Safety recommends that students supply their own face mask, snorkel and boots as sharing these items may lead to disease transmission. Students can supply their own or purchase a new set to use in the future. Students purchasing new equipment will be assisted with their selection by our trained staff or your instructor. Any equipment used during the course must meet safety criteria and be authorised by your instructor.

This is just the beginning! Your Open Water Diver Certification will allow you to purchase or hire dive equipment and dive from charter boats and dive resorts all over the world.

Sub Aquatics through its dive club 'Club Sub Aquatic' offers weekly local dives, also regular weekend getaways and holidays interstate and overseas.
